



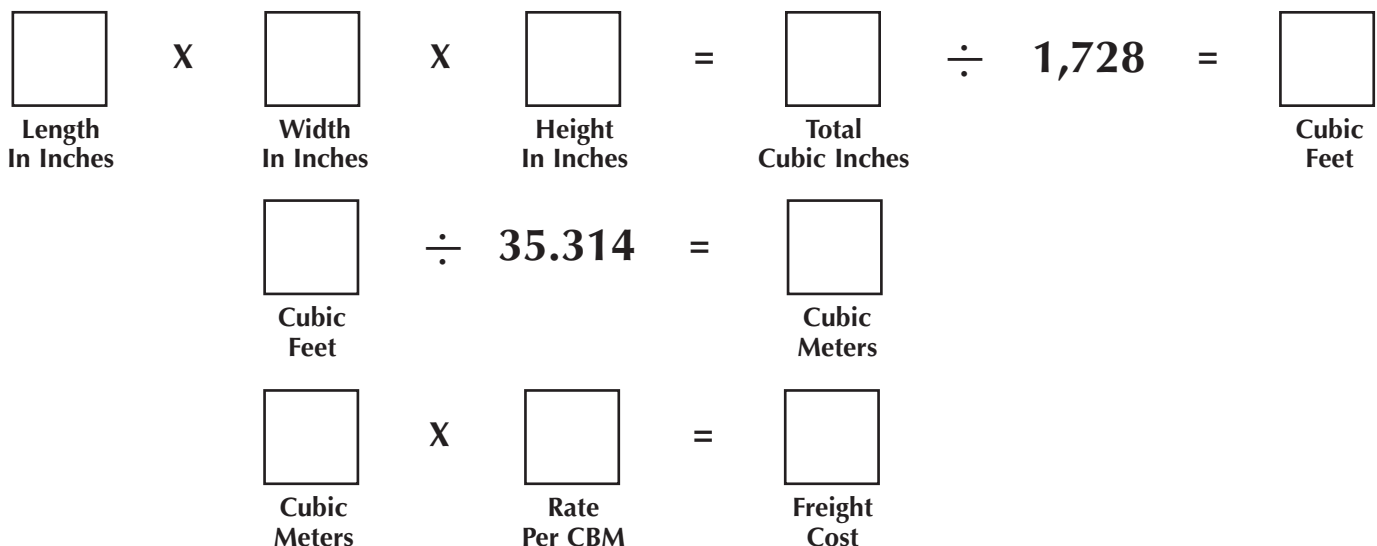

Normal gross weight limitation over the road payload in the Far East is 22 tons. Dimensions are approximate and vary according to container manufacturing specifications. Actual loading capacity is 85% of maximum depending on carton size.

CALCULATING CHARGEABLE WEIGHT VS. ACTUAL WEIGHT



Ocean freight cost is measured on a weight or measure basis (whichever is greater). The chargeable weight is determined by the metric ton (weight) or on the cubic meter (measure).
